Does the exhibition have a developed curatorial proposal?

Does the exhibition encourage new audience development and community participation relevant to visual arts practice?

Does the exhibition stimulate discourse and debate and provide educative support material?

Does the exhibition have empathy with the overall objectives of the cultural activities of the Burnie Regional Gallery?

Does the exhibition have the potential to tour in some form?
